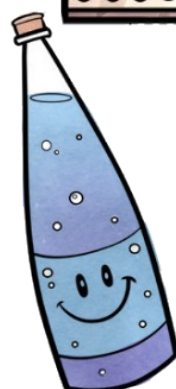

We propose to you a very funny game of tracks, ideal to enjoy and rediscover Caldes de Malavella in a different way. No guide is needed, you can do it any day and any time, with friends or your family. The activity is oriented to fun.

-9 tests

If you have downloaded the material online, it is not necessary to go to the Tourist Office at the beginning of the game. Throughout the adventure, you will discover letters that you must place in order in the box of the mysterious cover, which will reveal the superpower of the Esquitxons. In total you will find 8 letters, one in each box where you will solve the riddles of the game. The evidence you find during the gymkhana are not relevant to the resolution of the enigma, but will make the proposal more entertaining.

It is very important that you don't move on to the next clue until you have solved the previous one, that's part of the fun! ;)

Caldes de Malavella is a unique town, as it has a resource that is not found everywhere: thermal waters. Since ancient times, people from all over the world have come to enjoy these miraculous waters for their healing and historical benefits. To protect and preserve this legacy, a group of Caldenca superheroes emerged to watch over the healing properties of these waters. They call themselves **Els Esquitxons**, but who are they really? Are you curious to find out? Then joining us in this adventure, follow the clues and discover the true identity of the Esquitxons and what their secret superpower is.



TRACK 1

You meet Detective **Radobert Lupalull**, who will accompany you on this mission.

—Good morning, new recruits. Are you ready to discover the mystery of the Esquitxons? So, you want to help me? Where do we start? Any ideas? Shut up! If we need information, the most logical thing to do is to go to the Tourist Office, right?

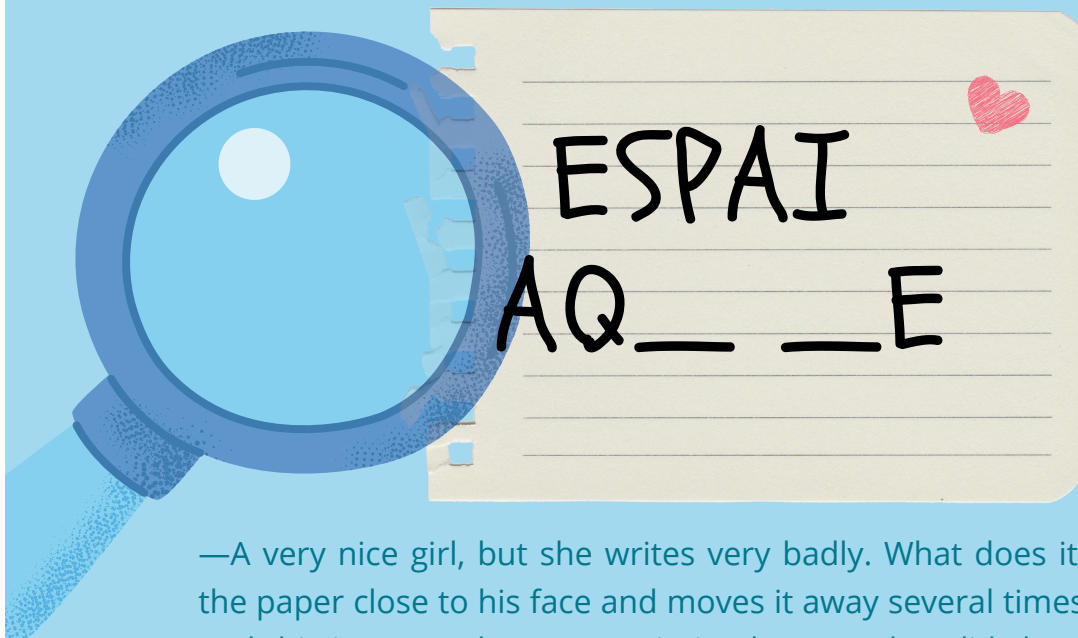
—Good morning we are here to ask you for information.

—Oh, very well, then I can give you this map...she says kindly.

—No, we didn't understand each other. We need information...confidential...he clarifies.

—Oh! Then... it is clear where you have to go. It is a place that stores all the knowledge of Caldes. Go up to the second floor and you'll find her in her lab, enthusiastically cleaning a tibia of...What is it, Dr. Jane?

—Dra. Jane?

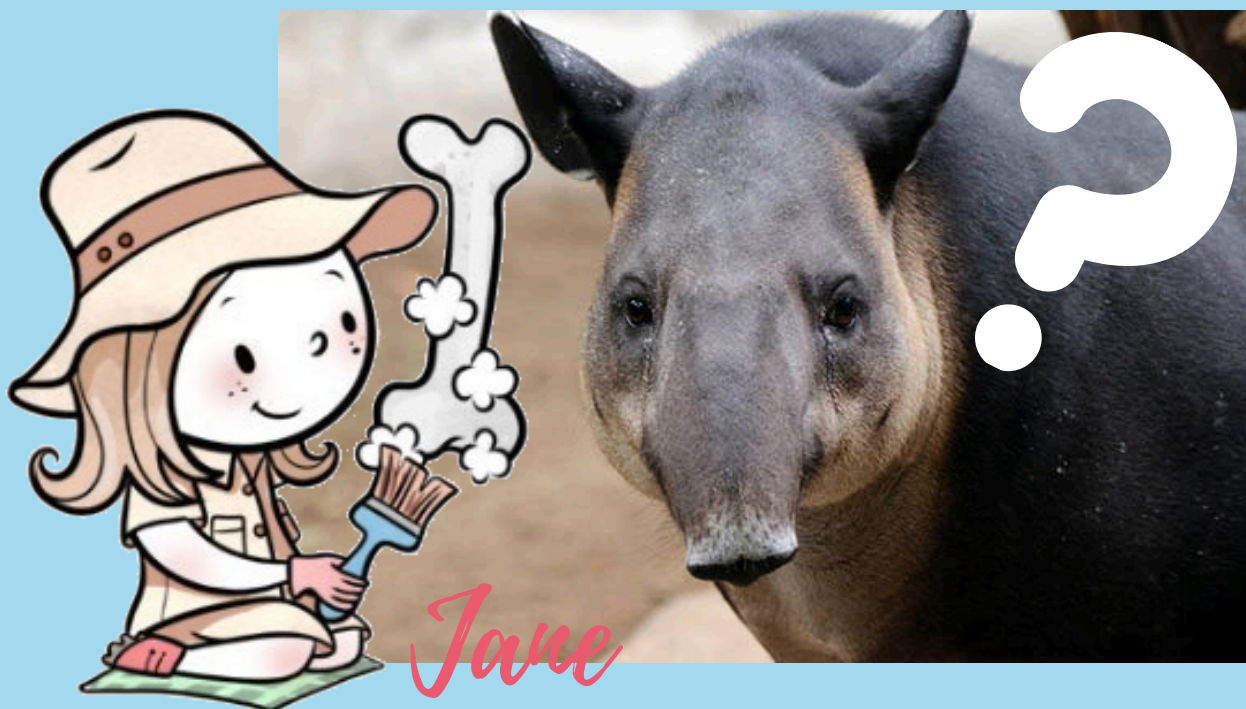
—¡Wait a minute, “she says in a hurry, as she raises her hand to us”, Don't you think this **Tapirus arvernensis** is fantastic?

—Mmmm...Yes, yes, very nice. But we came to ask you a history question, since you are such a prestigious researcher in this field.

—¡History is my specialty, she says, pushing her messy hair out of her face. I can explain anything you want! What are you interested in?

—It has more to do with the water...

—Well, **water has to do with everything! he exclaimed!!** Water is a natural resource that has been available to us for a long time. In prehistoric times, before humans existed, the geological conditions already made this place very rich. Precisely the water emerges from the faults created underground at that time. Think that in Caldes there were volcanoes. In the crater that was in the **Camp dels Ninots**, when the volcanic activity ceased, a lake was formed. TRACK 3

—Oh, sorry, we didn't mean to disturb you! Dr. Jane sent us. My name is Radobert Lupalull, we're doing some research on the superheroes of Caldes, says Lupalull. I feel like cooling off in this pool too!

—Good morning! My name is Julian and I am a Roman citizen. So when we arrived, more than 2000 years ago, we became aware of the existence of the thermal waters of Caldes. This water has healing properties, so we could not miss it. That's why we founded an urban center that eventually acquired Latin law! Look, it even appears on this ancient road map.



What a thing! People didn't have Google Maps and yet they didn't forget to put Caldes (Aquae Calidae), says Lupalull. Every time we know more and more.

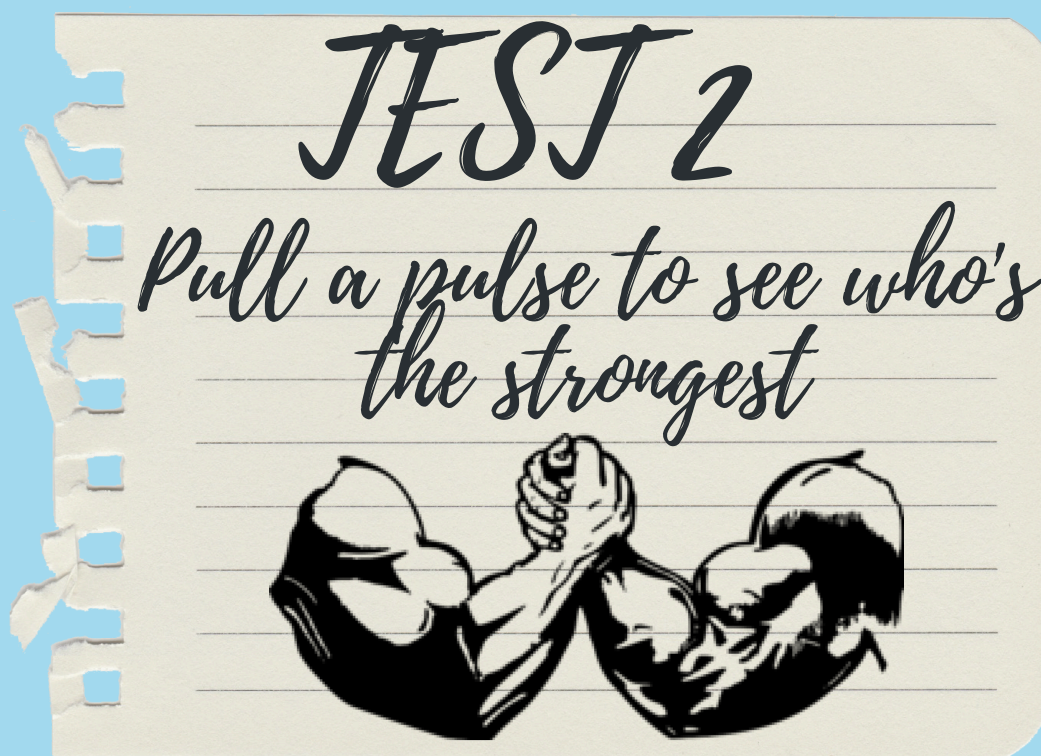
—You say Dr. Jane sent you," says the suspicious Roman.

TRACK 4

Indeed, we arrived at a rose-colored house, very stately. Sitting on the steps of the hot spring there is a girl who looks like she has stepped out of the beginning of the last century.

—Good morning, could you tell us what is so special about this building?

—Casa Rosa is one of the most important buildings in Caldes, a modernist building that belonged to the Mataró industrialist Pau Estapé, my father, who is the same man who first excavated the Roman Baths!

—We just came from there! "says the detective in surprise.

—As you will have seen on the panel in front of the house, which tells the **history of the bottling**, Casa Rosa was used as a residence but also to store the Imperial Water that Pau Estapé bottled.

—Bottling?...From a bottle?

—Exactly. The waters of Caldes have properties that make them suitable for the treatment of various diseases. This favored that they were bottled, that is, they were put in bottles and then sent far away so that patients could follow the treatment at home. This would be the origin of the industrial use of the thermal water, which became an engine of growth for Caldes, as the Petronella's heavy one keeps repeating...

—Who is Petronella?

—But then, are you an Esquitxo? insists the tireless detective. The girl lets out a long sigh, and ends up confessing to us.

—What does "hot spring" mean? You can't help but ask, curious.

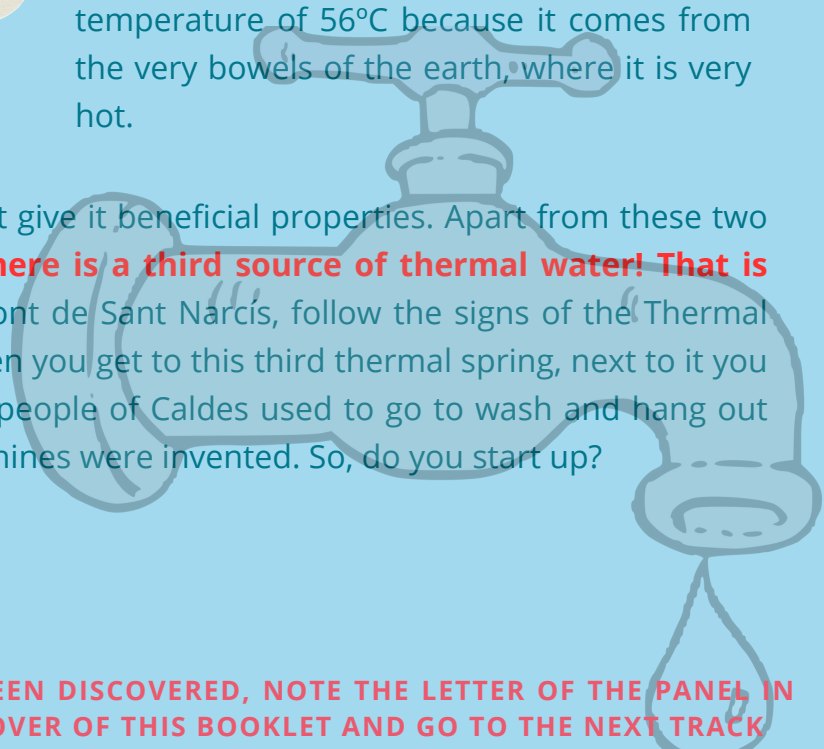
—Well, the water boils. It comes out at a temperature of 56°C because it comes from the very bowels of the earth, where it is very hot.

But how can it be bent like that? It is a crystal!!!

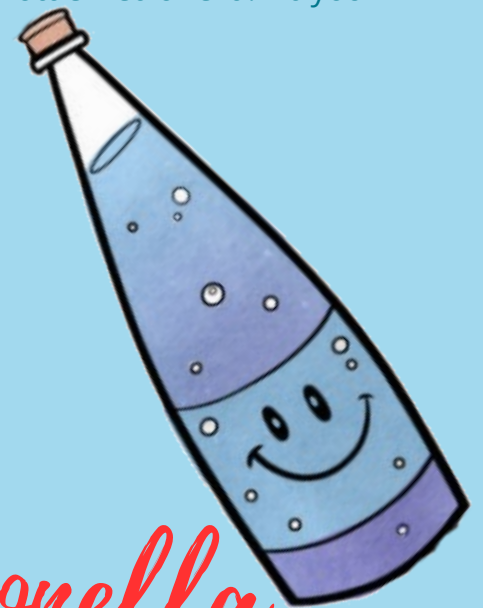

I see that you have a bit of Petronella in you with this flexibility and so now follow my indications and you will reach the next point from here (Font de la Mina) you can follow the Riera de Lleixiu, which is the pass that starts at the wash houses and goes through a small tunnel. At the end of it all, you will come to an imposing building with a 19th century arch. **The facade is very well decorated.** Look, like these that I show you in the photo and once on the facade look for the track that will show you the Muga:

You are breathless for a moment. Hhhhh-how? You mean... Heroes?

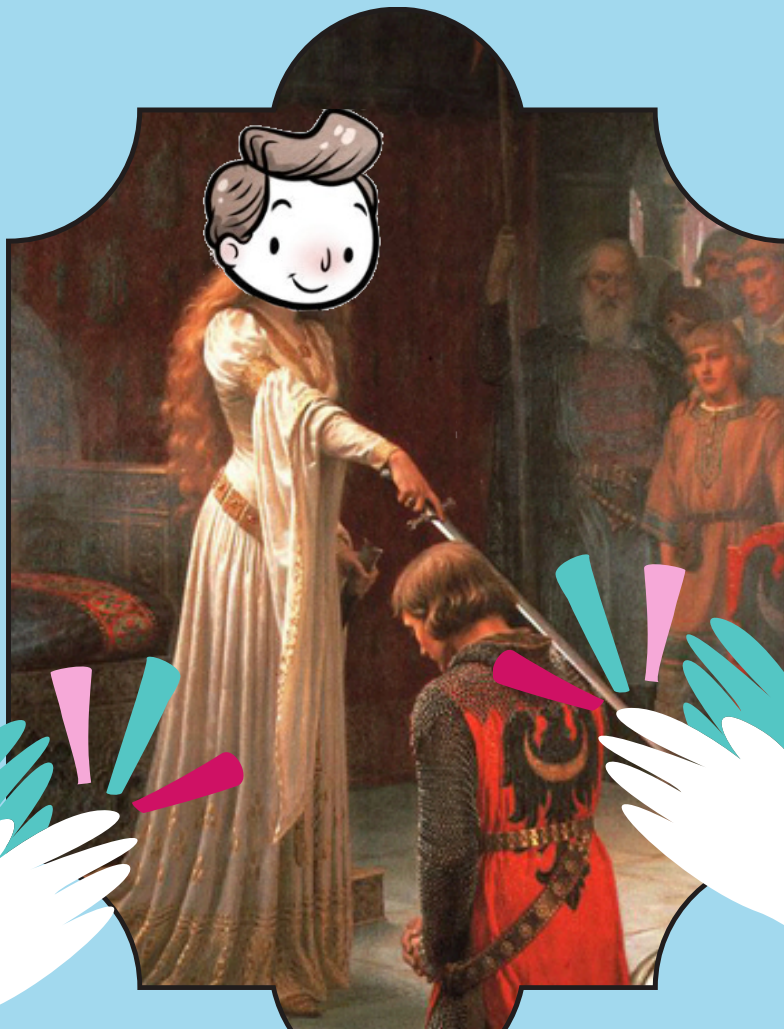
—From the Esquitxons? - asked Lupalull
